For example, flow out a PORV is stopped after a few minutes and then that flow is re-directed to a secondary containment. If the time steps are uncontrolled, excessive release from the secondary can occur. This significantly affects the results from TID source terms. Assessment of error: This error has been found to significantly affect dose results in at least one of the rebaselining phase 2 LOCA cases. Thyroid doses were increased by over a factor of 2. Note that the error generates more conservative results in all known cases.
